1 Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book. Classes will be conducted and judged in accordance there within.

2 All Morgan Horses entered in this competition must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association or the Canadian Morgan Horse Association, or if under one year of age must be eligible for registration.

3. No entry numbers will be distributed unless all necessary documentation & Health papers have been filed. A credit card or open check must be on file in the show office before entry numbers are given out.

5 Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Judge or Officials, on the part of any owner, rider, trainer or groom shall disqualify the horse and rider and the owner shall forfeit entry and other fees.

6 Adult exhibitors showing in Amateur classes are expected to be eligible for Amateur status as set for by current USEF rules and may be asked to provide proof of same

7. First and Second place horses must show back in In Hand Championships. No entry fee.

8 First and Second place entries must show back in corresponding Championship classes and must be entered in the show office. If qualified for more than one, entry in only one Championship is allowed. No post entry fees for entering Championship classes at the show.

9 All entry blanks must include complete address for Owner, Trainers and Riders. Date of birth must be provided for all Junior Exhibitors on entry blank.

10 Entries must be postmarked no later than May 25th

Horses entered after that date will be charged a \$20 late fee per horse. No late fee will be charged for horses duly entered that elect to add classes at the show.

11. Stall fees are \$65. Showing from Trailer will be \$25 per day. There will be no overnight stabling of horses in trailers.

12. There will be an office fee of \$20 per horse owner.

13. A Novice class is open to horses that have not won three first place ribbons. A Limit class is open to horses that have not won six first place ribbons. USEF Rules apply with regard to Novice and Limit entries.

14 A Junior Exhibitor is defined as a person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday as of December 1st of 2011.

15 PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: It is mandatory for all riders in Hunter Seat Equitation and Leadline Classes. to wear ASTM/SEI approved headgear with properly fitting harness. Protective headgear is acceptable in any division or class without penalty by the judge.

16 A Negative Coggins Certificate (EIA) dated in 2011 or 2012 must be provided for all equine entries. All out of State Equine entries are required to have a Negative Coggins Certificate dated within 12 months of the show. All out of State Equines are required to have a Health Certificate dated within 30 days of the show. Proof of Rabies vaccination must be provided for all horses.

17 There will be a surcharge of \$25 on all returned checks

18 CHEMUNG COUNTY RESTRICTS SMOKING AT THE FAIRGROUNDS. NO SMOKING IS PERMITTED AT OR NEAR THE BARN. SMOKING IS PERMITTED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.

19 All Dogs must be leashed.

20 A sound system will be provided. However all exhibitors are reminded that they are responsible for determining when their class will be held, and for presenting themselves on time for their scheduled class.

21 All premium checks will be mailed within 30 days.

22. Should any question or dispute arise which is not provided for in these rules, said question or dispute shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision will be final.

23 It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to officially scratch entries for any class in which they do not plan to participate. There will be no refunds for scratched classes. Credit will be given toward post entries in other classes. Entry fees will be refunded upon request before May 25, 2012. After that date refunds will be given only for a bona fide casualty to an exhibitor's family or a veterinarian's certificate attesting to an illness or injury that will prevent a horse from showing. A \$25. Fee will be assessed on all refunds.

24 A \$65 camper fee will be charged to anyone camping on the grounds whether they are hooked to available services or not. This fee applies to persons sleeping in horse trailers or vehicles as the fairgrounds charges us a fee for anyone sleeping on the grounds. The \$65 fee covers Friday and Saturday. Additional nights will be \$35 each.

25 Rings and footing. Main ring is Approx 150 x285. Footing is sand.

ALL ENTRIES MUST INCLUDE COMPLETE ADDRESSES AND BIRTHDATES OF ALL JUNIOR EXHIBITORS. A COPY OF ALL REGISTRATION PAPERS, NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST & RABIES CERTIFICATES WITH ENTRIES.

MOI73 General:

Open to Riders who are less than twelve years old (GRI26) To be judged on the rail at the walk and trot only. Rider must not have been judged in ANY saddle class, test or pattern that has required a canter in a recognized or non-recognized competition. Riders may not enter any other class in the competition in which they are competing with the exception of other walk and trot classes, driving, fitting and showmanship, and other non-canter events. Stallions are prohibited. Equipment, attire & presentation must match the discipline being ridden and the class entered. Protective headgear is acceptable. Horses must not be asked to back. Before horses are judged in the line up, one attendant, without whip, per entry will be permitted in the lineup and will be called in by the announcer. Attendant must stand back for the entry to be judged.

CARRIAGE DRIVING SECTION

USEF Chapter CP Rules will apply. Vehicles may be of the 2 or 4 wheeled type. Wire wheels, martingales and overchecks are not allowed. Side checks are optional. Live pool bits or any other traditional driving bits are allowed. A throatlatch and cavesson are mandatory. One

Or two handed style of driving is optional. At all times in The ring drivers Must wear a hat (ASTM/SEI Helmet for Juniors) gloves, apron or lap robe, and carry a whip in one Hand. Anyone failing to do so must be penalized by the Judge. Any Junior Driver not wearing approved headgear must be eliminated from the class. Under no circumstances

Should a bridle be removed from a horse while still put to a Vehicle. Such action will result in immediate elimination.

1. Carriage Driving Timed Obstacles

To be driven over a prescribed course of obstacles not to exceed 15 obstacles. After passing the starting line, the driver shall proceed through each obstacle to a designated finish line. Course faults are scored as penalty seconds and are added to the driver's elapsed time. 5 seconds for each dislodged or knocked down obstacle. Missing an obstacle

means elimination. Placings are determined on low time basis. Canter is prohibited.

2. Carriage Driving Scurry Obstacles

To be driven over a course of unnumbered obstacles consisting of cones, and rails. After passing the starting line competitors shall proceed at a trot through each obstacle in any order or direction. Each obstacle must be

Driven once. Upon completion of the course the Whip must

cross the finish line where time will be taken. A 5

Second penalty will be assessed for dislodging a ball or any part of an obstacle while on the course. Run outs or refusals will not be penalized. The circling rule does not apply. Canter is prohibited. The first three breaks into the canter will each incur a 5 second penalty. The fourth break, or any prolonged cantering will incur elimination.

Missing an obstacle, the use of tie downs or over checks and failure to carry a whip will incur elimination. Ties for

First place will be decided by a drive off.

3. Obstacle Driving – Your Route/My Route

To be driven over a course of Numbered obstacles. Driver is to complete course in correct sequence. The Driver must then drive all of the obstacles again in any order and in either direction choosing his/her own route

46. Carriage Driving Working Pleasure

A pleasure driving class in which entries are judged primarily on the suitability of the horse to provide a pleasant drive. To be judged 70% on performance, manners and way of going, 20% on condition and fit of the harness and vehicle, 10% on neatness of attire.

47. Carriage Driving Reinsmanship

A pleasure driving class in which entries are judged primarily on the skill of the driver. To be shown at a walk, slow trot, working trot and strong trot. Drivers will be required to rein back. All Drivers chosen for a workout may be asked to execute a figure eight or perform another appropriate test. To be judged 75% on handling of the reins and whip, control of posture and overall appearance of the Driver, 25% on condition of the harness and vehicle, and neatness of attire.
