PATRICIA LONG, Longacres, Johnstown, NY

Patricia Long has been actively involved in the breeding of quality Morgan horses since 1956. She and her husband Donald promoted a stallion, Lord Linsley, as well as the get of another stallion, Shadow Haw, in the 1960's...both stallions obtained through collaboration with Helen Brunk Greenwalt of Illinois. Don and Pat were active in the Mid-Atlantic Morgan Club where they were named life-time members, as well as in the NY State Morgan Association, where Pat was the recipient of the Silver Horseshoe Award in 1974.

Her efforts have focused on maintaining a limited but active breeding program since the untimely death of Donald Long in 1981. Mrs. Long's broodmares descended essentially from the foundation mare Ginger Mildann, sired by Allen's Major (by Cornwallis). Her daughters, sired by sons of Upwey Ben Don ... Milady Dona and Milady Success accounted for much of the next generation. Crosses to WC Beamington, co-owned with Helen Greenwalt, produced several popular show horses, including the farm's good producers Successfully and Justadream. Mrs. Long's last generation of stock is the result of crosses of those mares with the Noble Flaire bloodline thanks to a long-time affiliation and friendship with Thomas Caisse. She remains a dedicated advocate of the Morgan breed, and her program will be continued by her sons, building on the foundation of her established broodmare lines.
