

**N.Y.S. EASTERN DISTRICT MORGAN HORSE SOCIETY OPEN HORSE SHOW
August 6, 7, 8, 2010--Fonda Fairgrounds, Fonda, NY 12068**

Horse Show Rules and Regulations:

- 1) The fairgrounds will be open Friday AM-August 6th.
- 2) Each horse must have a legible, current coggins & rabies certificate.
- 3) **ONE CHECK PER ENTRY FORM!!** One number per horse. All riders of horse will use the same number.
- 4) Entries close July 25, 2010. Post entries will be charged \$1.00 extra per class. Only pre-entry stall & entry fees will be refunded if an authentic veterinary certificate is received by the show secretary no later than the start of the show.
- 5) Entry Fees: \$7 per class—Jr. Exhibitor & Equitation; \$9 per class-- Performance & In Hand; \$9 per class—Walk Trot/Jog & Equitation Championships; \$13 per class—Performance Championships. Classes entered after July 25th will be charged an additional \$1 late fee per class entered.
- 6) Classes must be paid for as entered or a blank check left at the secretary's office. **ONE CHECK PER ENTRY FORM!!**
- 7) There will be no stall reservations without payment & entry in at least 1 class. Stalls have half doors. All horses staying overnight must be stabled. One horse or pony per stall.
- 8) Stall fees: One horse or pony per stall at \$30 a stall. Tack stalls are \$35 a stall. Any stall used must be paid for. Stalls used without payment will be subject to a \$40 fee. No initial bedding is provided.
- 9) A \$10.00 grounds fee per day will be charged for each horse without a stall. This fee is per horse-per day
- 10) Beginner, Academy, Leadline, & Walk-trot/jog riders are eligible for only certain classes. See the rule book www.NYSSHA.org on line for details.
- 11) Tack changes are to be reported to the Secretary's desk at least 2 classes in advance. There will be a 3 minute hold allowed for the change.
- 12) Classes may be added, combined, split, or deleted at the discretion of the show chairperson. Classes with less than 10 entries will run as a sweepstakes.
- 13) Supervised schooling for the jumping classes will be held from 7:30 to 8:00 Saturday morning.
- 14) Morgans may enter EITHER the Morgan In Hand OR the Open In Hand but not both. Morgan Classic Pleasure Horses may enter other divisions.
- 15) Inquiries to the judge MUST be directed through the show chairperson.
- 16) There will be end of show awards in the Western, Hunt Seat, Saddle Seat, Walker, and Pony, Mini, and Morgan divisions.
- 17) Prizes:
 - **Trophy & 6 ribbons**--- Jr. Exhibitor, Equitation, Beginner, Academy, Leadline & Equitation Championships
 - **\$20, \$15, \$10, and 6 ribbons**—In Hand & Performance
 - **Trophy, \$25, \$20, \$15, & 6 ribbons**—Performance Championships
- 18) There will be a \$30 per night per camper hook-up fee. All campers must display their paid camper card in the left hand corner of the vehicle.
- 19) NYSSHA rules will be observed. The rulebook is available online at www.NYSSHA.org or at the show office.
- 20) Per NYS law ALL children 13 & under must wear an ASTM approved helmet when riding or driving any equine as must ALL academy riders. All riders in Sit-A-Buck must wear a helmet.
